

Road Committee Report July, 2009

This year recycled asphalt was applied to 1.2 miles of Retreat road. Bulwark Ridge for .8 miles and Copper Hill for .4. One truckload was also applied to the steep sharp curve on Elkridge. Cost of the recycled asphalt will be approximately \$9,000 . I wish to thank: Dennis Bicknell, Rich Gilmore and Ron Spurlin for their help in making this road project a success.

At the May Board of Directors meeting the board decided to opt into Larimer Counties' road sign project. This project will erect new signs on all Retreat Roads; they will be brown with white reflective lettering. After the signs are installed the county will maintain them. The signs are made of metal and will be affixed to breakaway metal posts. Some roads will be renamed in order to avoid confusion with like road names in nearby communities. The roads to be renamed are: Copper Hill Court will become Sheep Lane, Elkridge Court will be changed to Wild Elk Court, and Bulwark Ridge Court to Leaping Bobcat Lane. This project should be completed sometime in July of this year.

The Road Committee has decided to delay replacing the snowplow until 2011. Due to the light winter, it didn't receive undue wear.

The capital campaign fund is still accepting donations. This fund was established to help pay for a new snowplow. The current balance is \$4,610.
