

## **Road Committee Report September 2012**

**Grading and watering of RLA roads continue; the roads seem in good condition. The culverts have been inspected and those needing it were cleaned.**

**While most of the roads look in good condition, the occurrence of washboards is becoming more frequent. This is due to the recycled asphalt wearing away, especially on those roads where it was applied four and five years ago.**

**The application of recycled asphalt on selected portions of Streamside and Miller Fork has been rescheduled for May 2013, pending budget review.**

**The pickup's front end was rebuilt and is no longer a safety threat. Rich is currently overhauling the snow plow's hydraulics and installing new hoses. The snow plow will be ready for this winter season.**

**The use of the slash pile has doubled this year. Half of it has been chipped and the other half will be chipped this fall.**

**Those of you who have used the slash pile undoubtedly noted the gate without a fence. The new owners of the Lindsey property took the barbed wire fence down and it is reported they will replace it with a corral type fence. No word on when it will be replaced.**
